OCTOBER

OCT. 2

We thank God for his provision and protection of our teams in Russia, Ukraine and Belarus. Despite obstacles, they have been able to produce new programs almost every day.

OCT. 3

We are grateful to God for the massive growth of the social media platforms in Central Asia. Besides positive comments, they also receive quite a few with threats and curses. Please pray for wisdom and protection of our staff.

OCT. 4

After being prevented from taking place for two years by COVID, the RTM Latin America partners annual meeting is underway now through Friday in Honduras. Ask the Holy Spirit to move powerfully in their midst.

OCT. 5

We praise God for fruitful servant-leadership training in our Europe and CAMENA¹ region and our Americas region already this year. Please pray for the sessions that will take place this month and next in Africa and Asia.

OCT. 6

Pray for the smooth operation of our partner's new FM station in the West African nation of Côte d'Ivoire. Our goal is to minister to the 362,000 people of Yamoussoukro, where the station is located, and the

surrounding region of Muslim-background believers and unreached people groups.

OCT. 7

Please lift up Daryl and Carol VanDyken, TWR missionaries since 1989. Recently returning from Cyprus to a posting in the U.S., Daryl serves remotely as technical director for Europe and Carol is transitioning to a caregiver role for family members.

OCT. 8

The SON-Lift project, which is aired by TWR on shortwave radio from Guam, brings the light of gospel truth to people groups in China. Please pray for smooth operation as it is being produced in two new languages

OCT. 9

Pray that many people find their way to God amid suffering and destruction in Ukraine.

Praise God for evidence that this is occurring. Please ask that the programs and content of our team in Ukraine may provide help, healing and hope.

OCT. 10

Pray for spiritual fruit from the *Worship ConneXion* live daily broadcast that originates in our Johannesburg studios. It is being carried on FM stations throughout Africa, as well as online and via satellite to homes.

OCT. 11

We ask our Father God for strength and perseverance for our team in Central Asia so that they may fulfill their mission and continue to tell the people of their country about Jesus.

OCT. 12

This is a season of leadership transition for our partners at RTM Chile. Please pray on their behalf as they continue in the mission to bring the gospel of hope to their nation.

OCT. 18

OCT. 19

RTM Paraguay is producing new programs in the Guarani language, which is spoken in Paraguay. Pray that these programs may have a deep impact on their audience and be distributed by more radio stations throughout the region.

OCT. 20

Please stand in prayer with Christians in Nigeria. Recent attacks, including the kidnapping of notable ministers of the gospel in Nigeria, clearly show that prayer is needed. Our God will deliver his people.

OCT. 21

OCT. 22
